

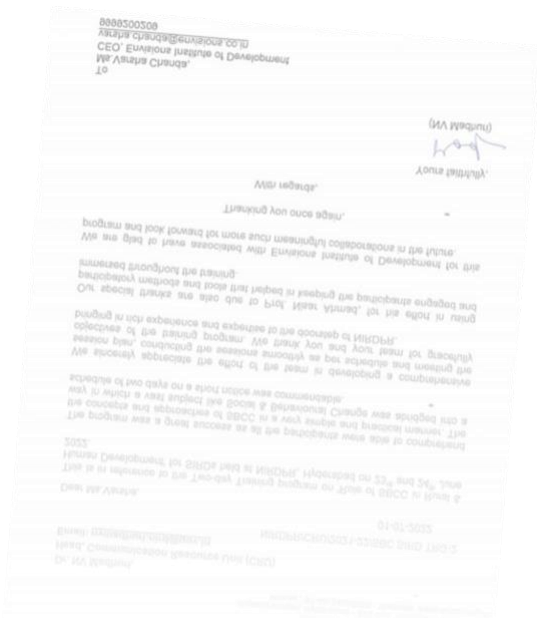

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SUMMARY

During the year 2022-23, Envisions Institute of Development (EID) worked for UNICEF, and Association for Rural Advancement through Voluntary Action and Local Involvement (ARAVALI), Rajasthan. These assignments covered a wide range of developmental issues, such as:

- Health – Routine Immunization, COVID-19 Vaccination
- Water and Sanitation
- Solid & Liquid Waste Management
- Livelihoods, Self-reliance and Panchayati Raj

PARTNERSHIP WITH UNICEF

The Partnership Cooperation Agreement 2018-2022 continued with 2021 Programme Document (PD) and new PD was signed in February 2022 for the year 2022. Due to lockdown measures and continuing COVID-19 pandemic the focus remained mostly on COVID-19 related work. Major highlights of the work done are given below.

COVID-19 FOCUSED TRAINING & RESEARCH

- Content revision in COVID updates for PRI for PRIMOV, Maharashtra
- Photo documentation for C-Vax in Maharashtra completed

ROUTINE IMMUNIZATION RELATED TECHNICAL SUPPORT

- RI perceptions dip-stick tool finalised and sampling plan approved. Field team training completed on 31st. Data collection to begin in the first week of April. Analysis begins. Final report submitted.
- RI costed plan is under review post feedback from health section. RI planning for Mah partner NGOs completed.
- eBRIDGE package presented to health section. Feedback incorporated and content finalised. LMS development and final version submitted.
- BRIDGE ToTs completed: Tripura (1), MCGM, Mumbai (1), Arunachal (2), Nagaland (1), Mah NGO (1), Mah Supportive Supervision & QA. 11 batches completed in Maharashtra by

strengthening partnership structures - collaborated with NIPHTR, MoHFW and engaged their faculty members as cofacilitators.

- Provided support to Ministry of Urban Affairs on development of communication strategy for SBM U 2.0
- NIDM SBC for DRR Toolkit: Ideation meeting facilitated, checklists developed
- Doctors For You - RI partner staff trained on use of SBC for RI demand generation.
- CBM 2.0 - 70 batches of training completed. Handholding support provided for development of micro-plans. 2 refresher batches completed

WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE

- Concept note for JJM CNA in Maharashtra finalised. Data collection completed in 5 districts. Final report and strategy submitted. JJM-MP: data collection completed; analysis shared with the state government. Communication strategy final draft post comments shared.
- Jharkhand - 1 batch for WASH SBCC covering 61 participants from government departments
- Rajasthan - 2 batches ToT on SLWM completed for Directorate SBM (G). After getting participants' feedback, the Principle Secretary & Mission Director requested for 3 more batches.
- Edited FBO strategy draft submitted. FBO guidance note finalised. Operational plans for 5 NGO from 3 NE states finalised.

ENGAGEMENT OF FAITH LEADERS & FAITH BASED ORGANISATIONS FOR SDG

- Faith leaders' training on risk communication and community engagement for COVID-19 was carried-out in the states of Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and for eight North-Eastern states in Assam. Post training the faith leaders actively set-up help desks for COVID-19 vaccination registration. Promotional camps were organized by faith leaders and faith-based organization (FBO).



- Faith leaders and FBO engagement mapping was completed for 14 states. It was used to develop a national faith engagement strategy for UNICEF.
