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SUMMARY

During the year 2023-24, Envisions Institute of Development (EID) began CSR implementation and worked with corporates like Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, Larsen & Toubro Public Charitable Trust, and DCM Shriram. PARTNERSHIP WITH WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION

INTEGRATED COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT FOR ONE HEALTH

Began a new project to develop national integrated community engagement guideline for One Health. Working closely with the National Centre for Disease Control, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, this guideline aims to strengthen community engagement and outreach efforts across states and district levels by providing key strategic guidance for undertaking community outreach activities for social and behaviour change. The national guideline is intended to serve as a practical tool to engage communities in tackling One Health challenges effectively.

PARTNERSHIP WITH BHARAT PETROLEUM CORP LTD

CSR PROJECT - SASHAKT JEEVAN IN DISTRICT JHANSI, UP

CSR project focusing on promotion of mother and child health was implemented in (42) forty-two villages in district Jhansi during June-December 2023. More than twenty-seven thousand (27532) communication activities like home visits, group meetings, and

influencers' meetings were conducted deploying 168200 communication nudges reaching out to a population of 213643.

CSR PROJECT – BAN PYNBHA JINGIM IN DISTRICTS RI-BHOI & EAST KHASI HILLS, MEGHALAYA

CSR project *Ban Pynbha Jingim* (Improving Lives) was implemented in 45 villages across two districts in Meghalaya. It focused on improving health and nutrition outcomes for women and children in the villages. The project was implemented from September to December 2023. The details of the activities and changes undertaken under the project is as follows:

- Community meetings conducted: 215
- Home visits: 1792
- Changes related to Routine Immunization: 28
- Changes related to Antenatal Care (ANC): 6
- Changes related to Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA): 323
- Nutrition gardens setup: 5
- Assistance provided in Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) registration: 50

New Partnership Cooperation Agreement IND/PCA20231178 was signed in December 2022 for the five-year period 2023-2027. Major highlights of the work done in 2023-24 are given below.

SYSTEMS STRENGTHENING FOR GOVERNMENT HEALTH SYSTEMS

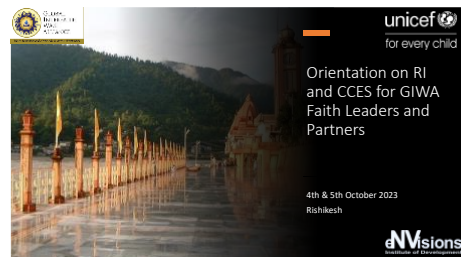
- INAP: Have shared INAP message matrix with ICO.

LEADERSHIP & SUPERVISION FOR RESULTS FOR GOVERNMENT HEALTH SYSTEMS

New agreement No 4500009413 was signed with Piramal Swasthya on 16th June 2023 to devise capacity development and systems strengthening interventions for an 18 month long programme on leadership and supervision for results (LS4R) in Assam, Chhattisgarh and Odisha.
